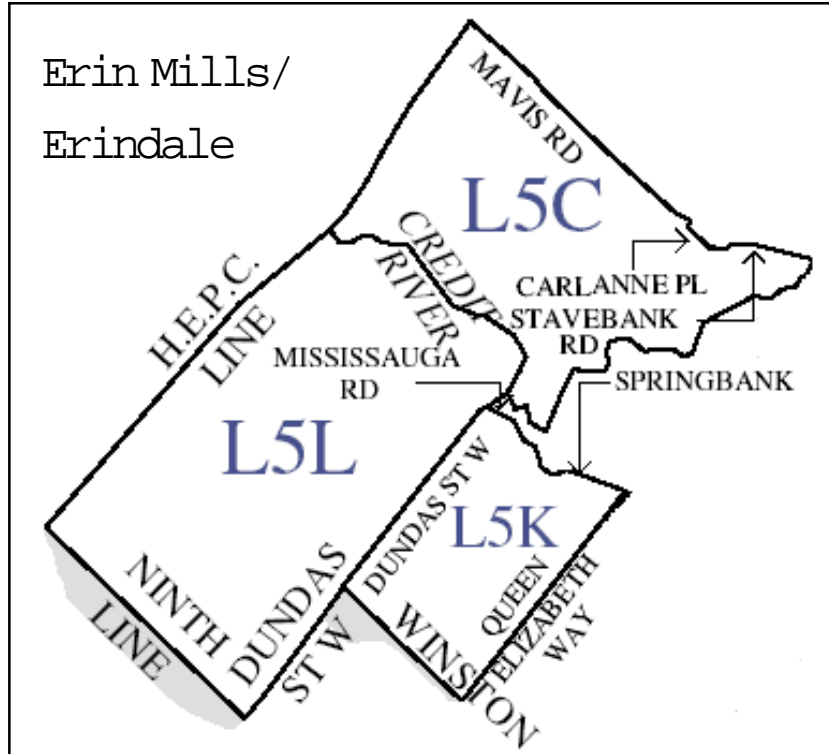

- The number of visible minorities in Erin Mills/Erindale increased by 18.2% between 1996 and 2001.
- In 2001, the three largest groups of visible minorities in Erin Mills/Erindale were South Asians (11,840), Blacks (5,375), and Chinese (5,040).
- The three fastest growing visible minority groups in Erin Mills/Erindale are the Korean, South Asian, and Japanese groups.

- The majority Erin Mills/Erindale residents (60.4%) indicated that English was their mother tongue (first language).
- The number of people with English as their first language declined by 5.5%, while the number of those with non-English first languages increased by 17.5%.
- In 2001, the top five mother tongue languages after English were Polish, Chinese, Urdu, Tagalog (Filipino), and Portuguese.
- The greatest population increase occurred among Urdu-speakers (129.6%), Arabic-speakers (40.1%), and Tagalog-speakers (35.5%).

Highlights:

- The number of single adults in Erin Mills/Erindale (never/not yet married) increased by 10.2%, (from 21,220 to 23,395), between 1996 and 2001.
- Between 1996 and 2001, the number of legally married (and not separated) people in Erin Mills/Erindale showed almost no change, experiencing a slight increase of 0.4%, (170 people).
- The number of widowed people decreased by 26.9% between 1996 and 2001, and the number of divorced or separated people increased by 27.8%, (from 5,495 to 7,025) in the same period.
- Overall, the divorced/separated group is growing at a faster rate than all of the other groups.

Highlights:

- Overall, unemployment declined significantly between 1996 and 2001 in Erin Mills/Erindale.
- In 2001, the labour force in Erin Mills/Erindale consisted of 54,810 persons over age 15, an increase of 4.9% over the 52,225 persons in the labour force in 1996.
- The labour force participation rate for Erin Mills/Erindale in 2001 was 73.3% compared to 72.9% in 1996.
- In 2001, there were 51,855 people employed in Erin Mills/Erindale, an increase of 7.9% from the 48,055 employed people in 1996.
- Erin Mills/Erindale's unemployment rate in 2001 for people aged 15 and over was 5.4%, down from the 1996 rate of 8.0%.

Highlights:

- The average family income in Erin Mills/Erindale was \$90,017 in 2000, an increase of 22.4% from the average family income of \$73,564 in 1995.
- Overall in Erin Mills/Erindale, families with higher incomes are growing at a faster rate than families with lower incomes.
- The highest rate of growth occurred among families that earned \$50,000 and over. This group increased by 15.2% between 1995 and 2000, from 16,270 to 18,735.
- In 2000, 71.2% of families in Erin Mills/Erindale earned more than \$50,000 per year, compared to 64.0% in 1995.
- The remaining family income groups decreased: the number of families that earned less than \$20,000 decreased by 28.6%, and the number of families that earned \$20,000 to \$49,999 decreased by 12.8%.

- In 2000, there were approximately 10,650 persons in private households living on low incomes. The 10,650 low-income persons represented approximately 11.3% of the total population in 2000, compared to 14.1% in 1995.
- In 2000, there were 2,530 low-income families in Erin Mills/Erindale. The 2,530 families comprised approximately 10.1% of the total number of families in Erin Mills/Erindale, compared to 12.9% in 1995.
- In 2000, there were 1,610 unattached individuals living on low incomes in Erin Mills/Erindale compared to 1,695 in 1995. They represented 29.6% of all unattached individuals in Erin Mills/Erindale in 2000.
- There was a higher incidence of low income among unattached individuals than among families in 2000: 29.6% versus 10.1%, respectively.
