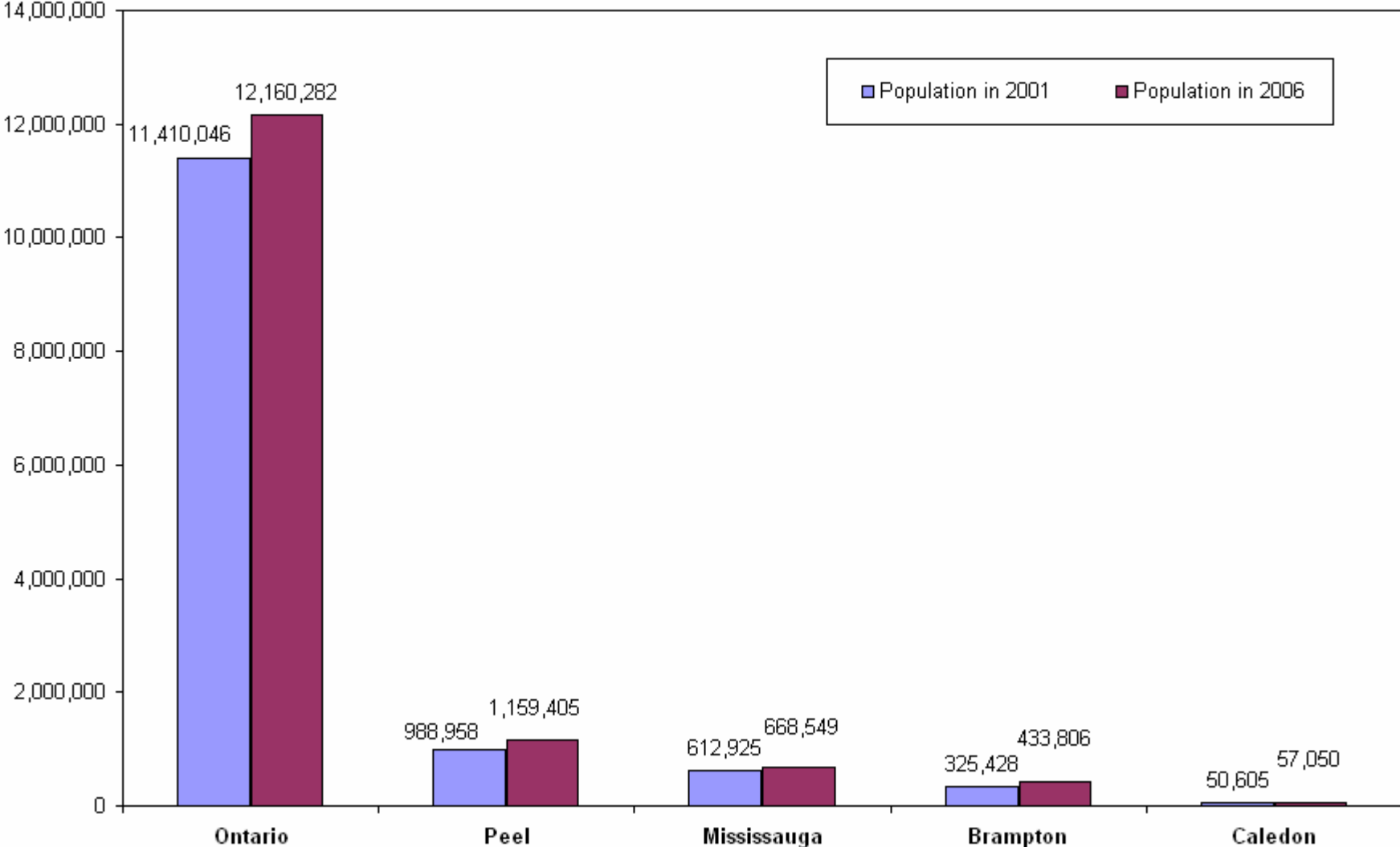

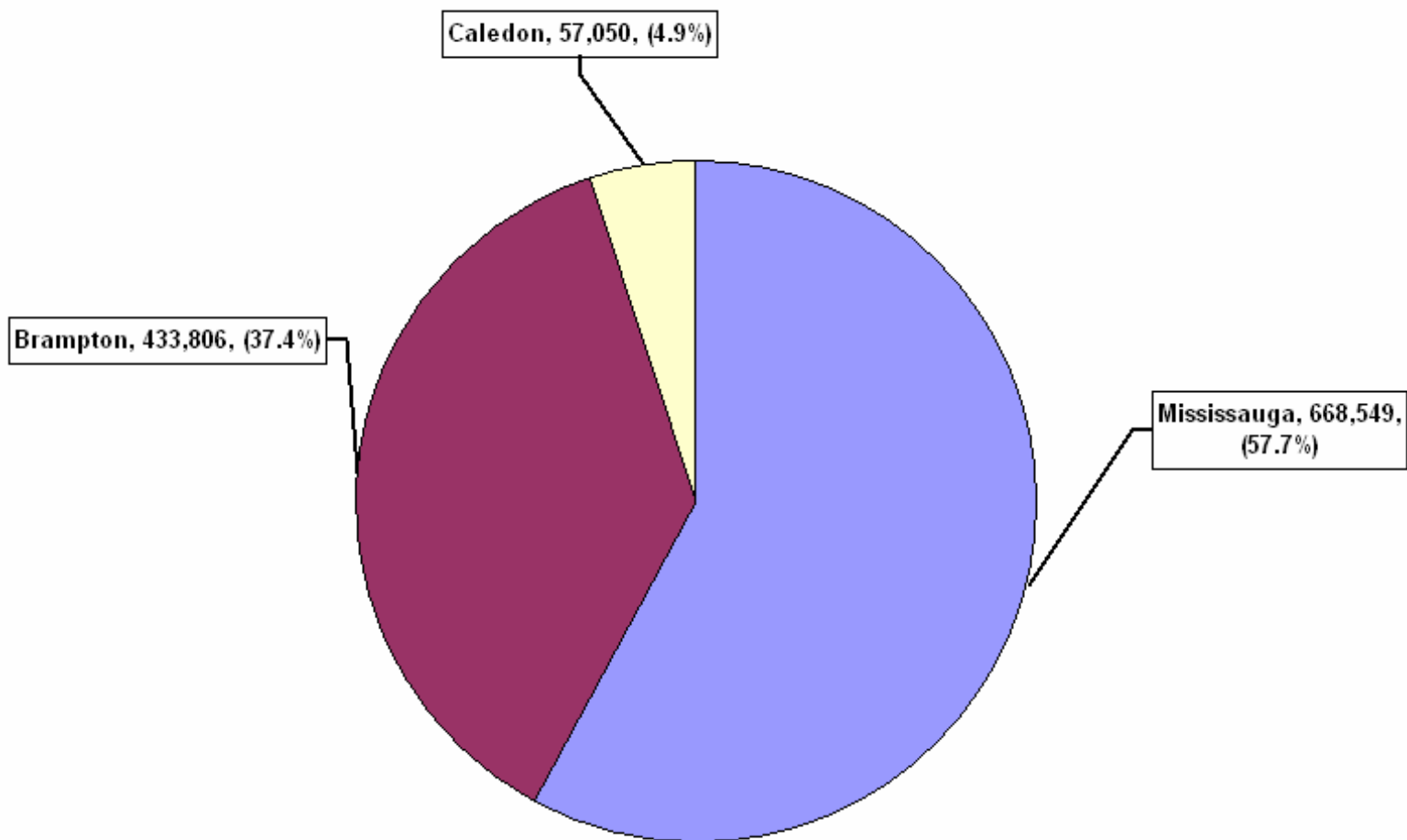
Background

POPULATION SIZE: ONTARIO, PEEL, MISSISSAUGA, BRAMPTON & CALEDON, 2001 & 2006

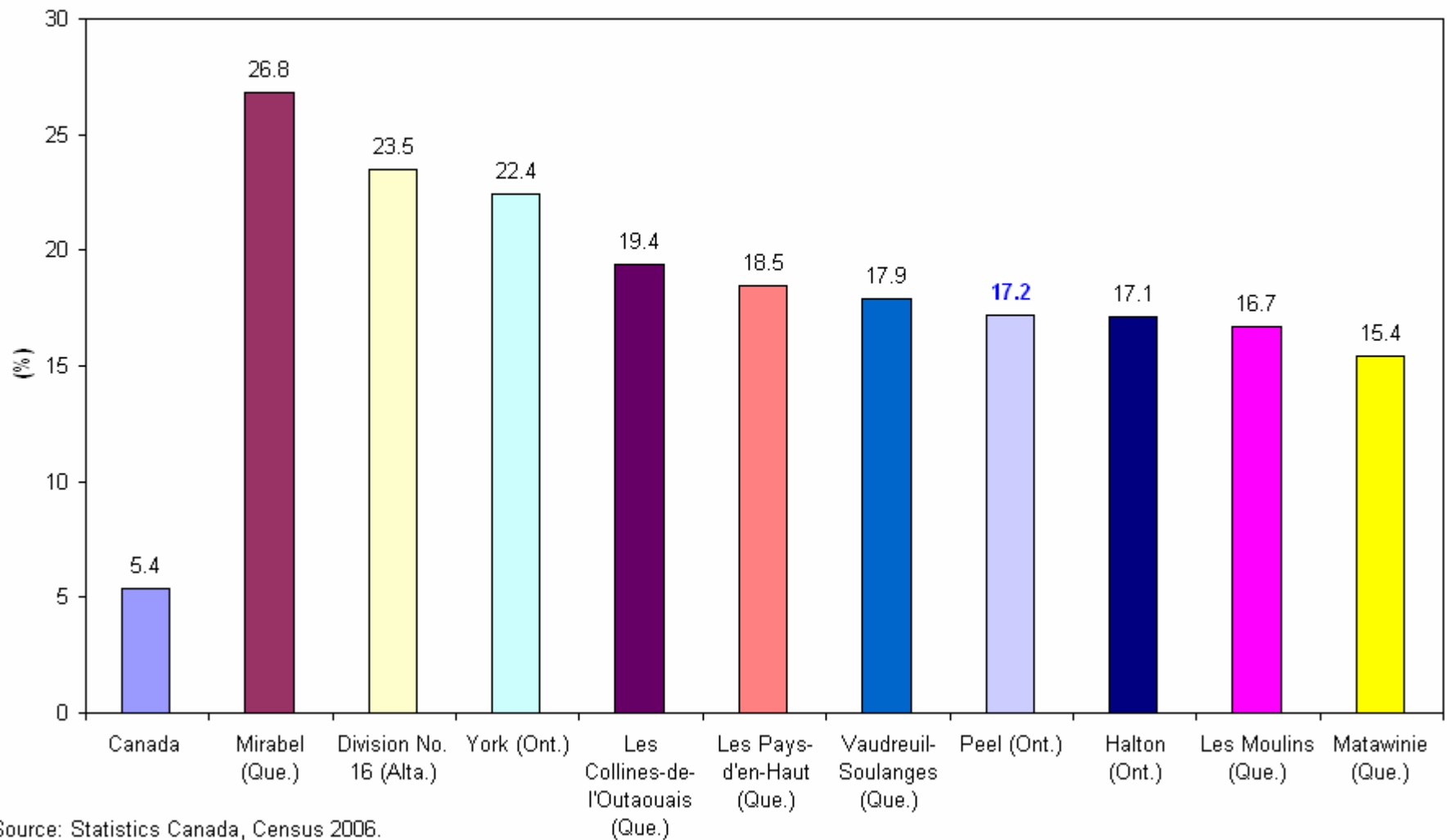


Distribution of the Population in Peel by Municipality, 2006



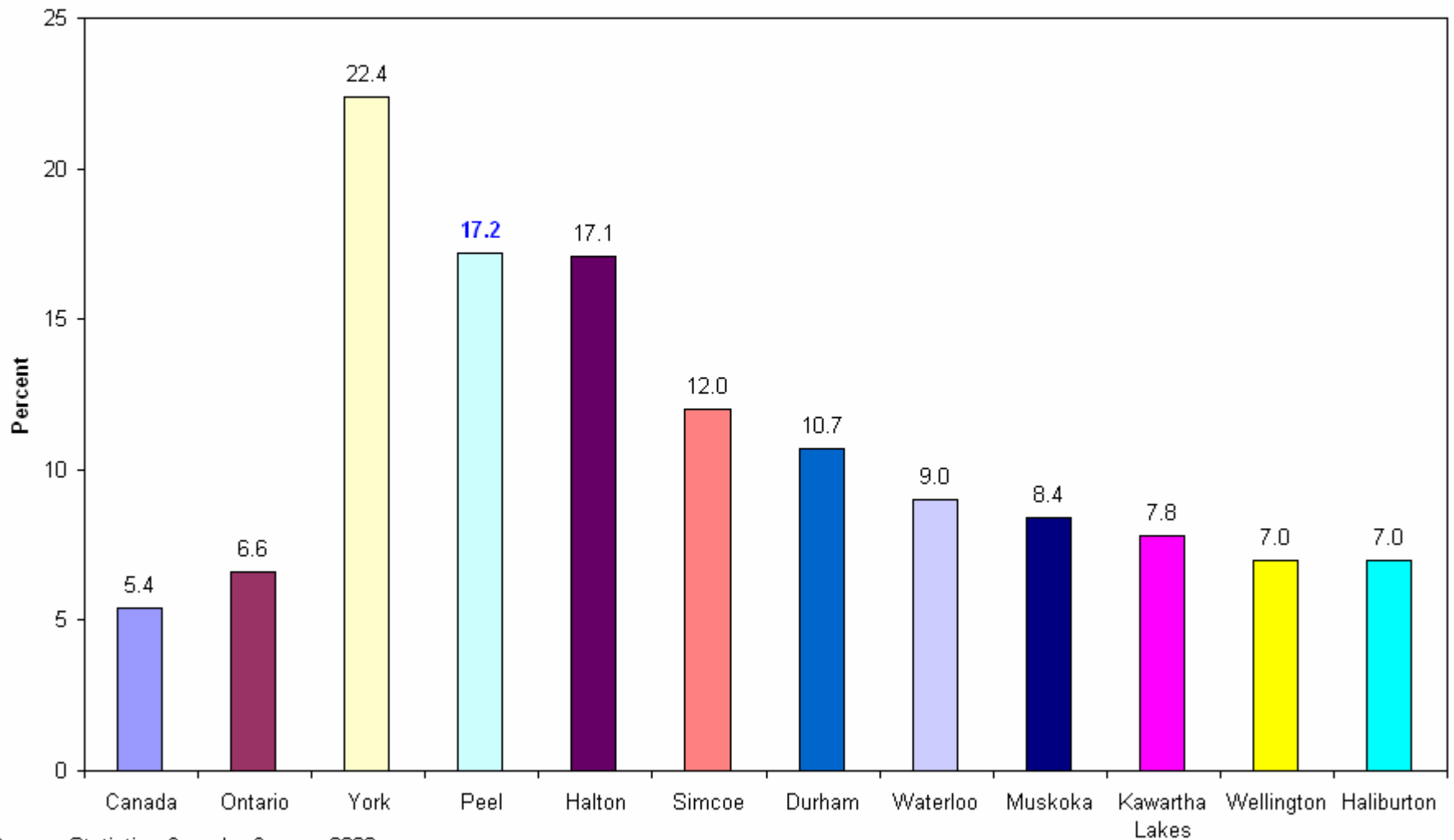

Population Growth between 2001 & 2006 by the Top 10 Fastest Growing Regions in Canada



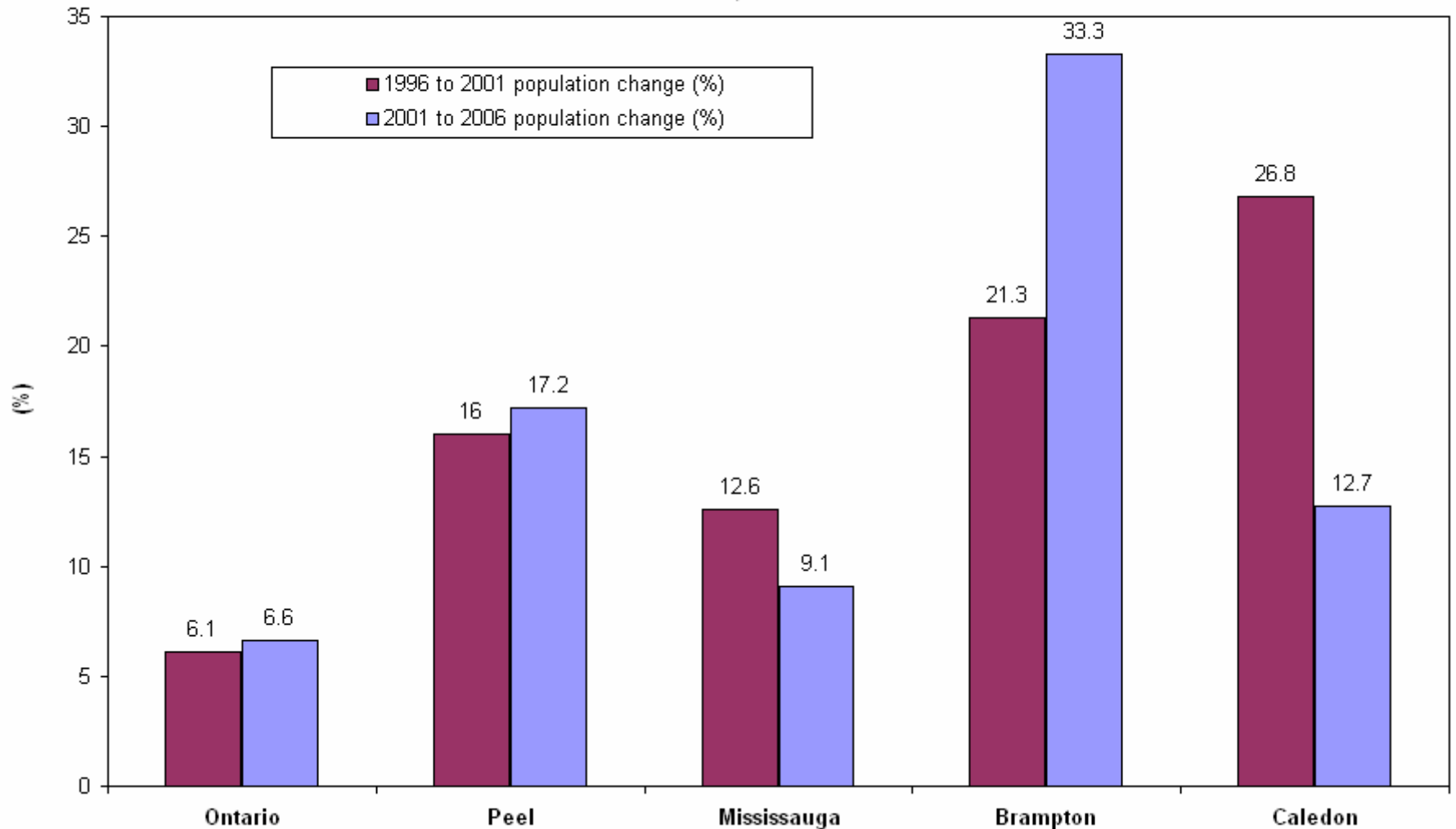

Population Growth between 2001 and 2006 by the Top 10 Fastest Growing Regions (Census Divisions) in Ontario, 2006



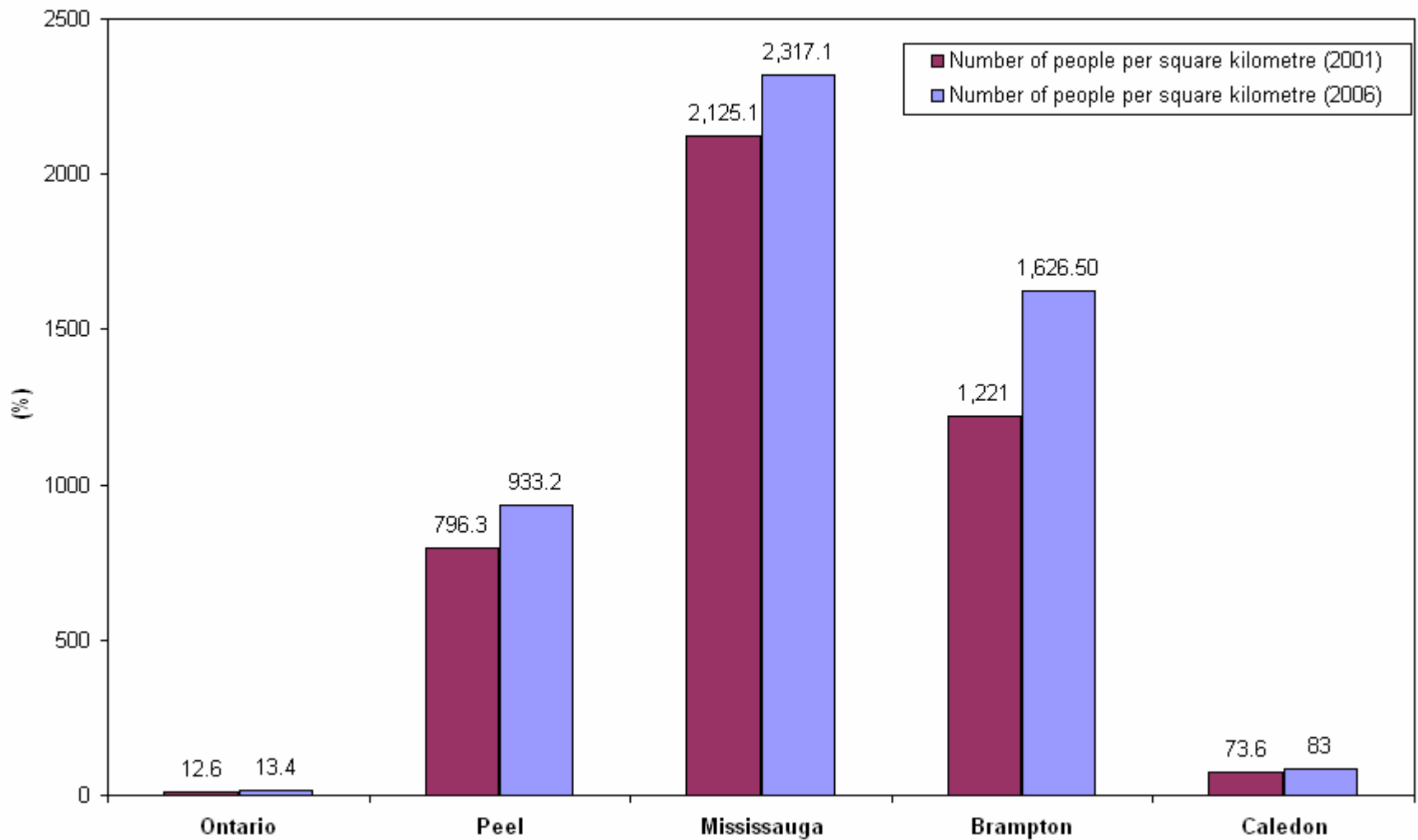

1996-2001; 2001-2006**



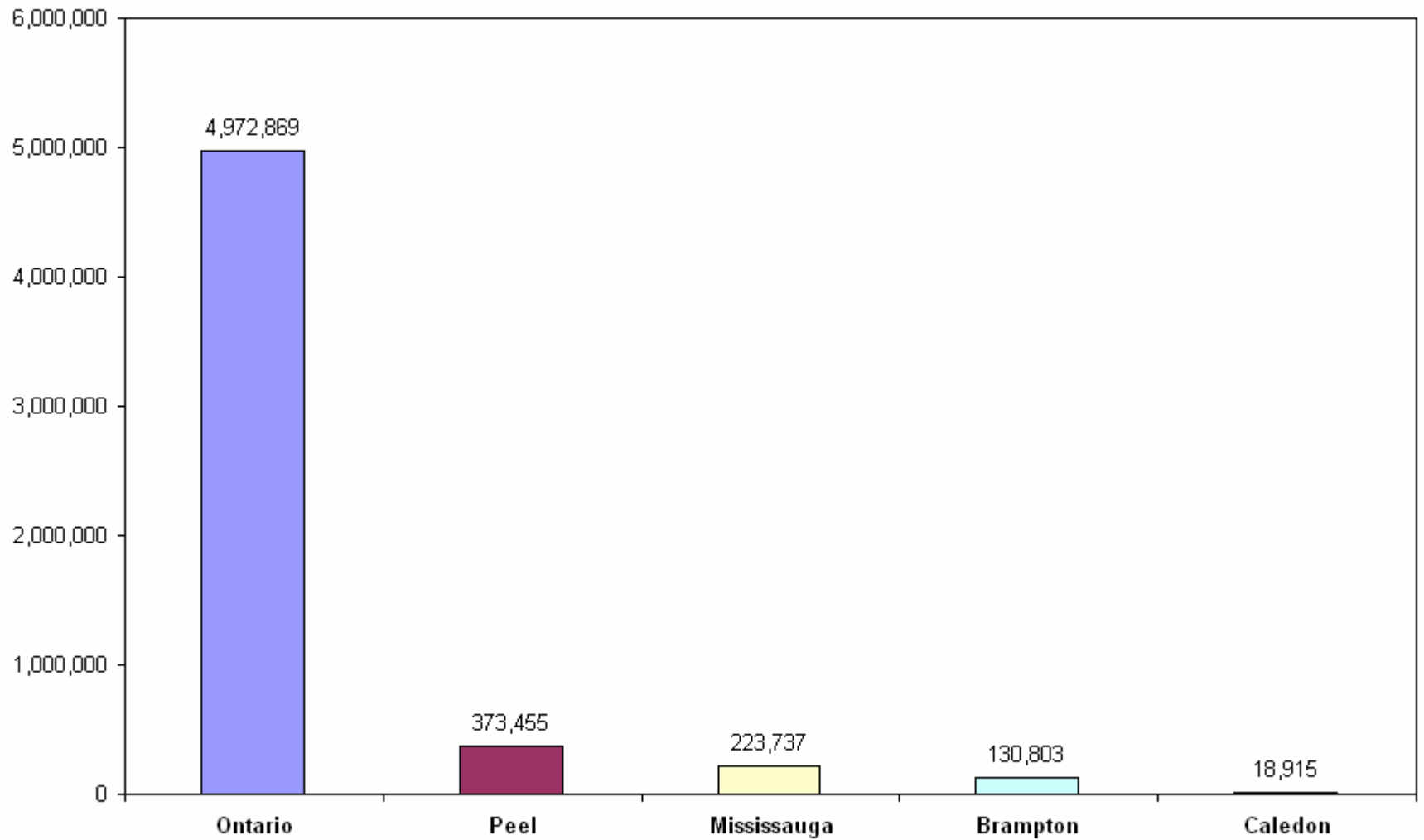
